Wedding Facility Fees 2009

Noseley Hall is able to seat up to 110 people at round tables using a combination of the [Library](#) and the Oak Hall, these spacious rooms interconnect with large double doors. The [Dining Room](#) is able to seat up to 60 people at either round or rectangular tables. Dancing can take place in a marquee attached to the house or in the [Stone Hall](#).

The facility fees for exclusive use of the Hall for a reception (without a Civil Ceremony or Chapel Blessing) are as follows for final numbers on the day:

Please note: For weddings on Saturdays during June, July, August & September, a minimum number of 65 guests will apply.

At present no VAT is charged on venue hire. If this rule changes we reserve the right to charge VAT on the facility fee at any time. Any equipment or furniture that has to be hired is charged to the client.

If you require a wedding breakfast for over 110 it is necessary to erect a marquee on the front lawn or the Chapel lawn. The facility fee is for exclusive use of the Hall and grounds for the day. Loos are provided in the Hall for numbers up to 150 (including evening guests), should this number be exceeded mobile loos need to be hired.

If you wish to hold a civil ceremony at Noseley Hall the cost would be £470 (under 25 £150)(no VAT is charged) for the use of one of the two rooms that are licensed. The administration and payment of the Registrar is the responsibility of the client. The telephone number of the Registrars' office is 0116 265 6565. It is not possible to hold a civil ceremony without a reception.

It is also possible to hold a Service of Blessing in the [C13th Chapel](#) in the grounds of Noseley Hall. The cost of the use of the Chapel is £550 and is payable to Noseley Chapel Trust (no VAT is charged). A vicar with organist and choir would conduct the service; costings for this are by arrangement with the vicar. We can give you the name of a vicar who will conduct the service and can arrange for a choir.

If booked before the 1st of July 2008, we will give a 5% discount on the above prices.
